III. OPENING REMARKS BY BOARD COUNSEL

Mr. Frizzell introduced himself and asked that all questions concerning procedures, authority, Florida Statutes, and Practice Act Rules be directed to him and questions concerning the facts of the case, the matter in which it was investigated and the reasons for the Department's recommendation be directed to the Department's attorney. Mr. Frizzell asked the panel the following questions: Did you receive all materials for today's meeting in advance of the meeting?

Ms. Buller: Yes.

Did you have enough time to thoroughly review the materials and familiarize yourself with the information presented within?

Mr. Frizzell reminded the panel that they were not there to determine the guilt or innocence of the person who is the subject of each case, but to decide if the facts of the record disclosed constitute probable cause for the Department to proceed formal charges probable cause exists.

IV. OPENING REMARKS BY THE AGENCY'S ATTORNEY

Mr. Den Beste introduced herself and stated that all members have been provided with a memo from the Department attorney addressing the requested action, a draft closing order regarding the Administrative Complaint, a copy of the original Administrative Complaint, and any other materials from the file deemed appropriate by the attorneys that supports the requested action. Additionally, Mr. Den Beste stated any materials received submitted by the licensee or counsel in reply to the proposed department action were enclosed.



V. RECONSIDERATIONS

A. RN-01 Kathlyn C. White, L.M.H.C., L.M.F.T., (AAC), Case No. 2018-27031

Mr. Den Beste presented the case to the panel. The department previously filed an Administrative Complaint against Ms. White for failing to meet the minimum standards of performance for an L.M.H.C. or L.M.F.T.. Ms. White was represented by Susan Byrd.

The Department recommends the removal of subparagraphs “a”, “b”, “c”, “e”, “f”, “g”, and “j” of paragraphs 6 and 9 from the complaint.

After discussion, the panel took the following action:

B. RN-02 Moshe Reznitzky, R.M.F.T.I., (AAC), Case No. 2019-34432

Mr. Den Beste presented the case to the panel. The department previously filed an Administrative Complaint against Mr. Reznitzky for failing to meet the minimum standards of performance for an R.M.H.C.I. or R.M.F.T.I.. Mr. Reznitzky was represented by Manuel Centurion.

The Department recommends the removal of subparagraphs “f” and “g” of paragraphs 6 and 9 from the complaint.

After discussion, the panel took the following action:

Motion: by Ms. Buller to accept Department’s recommendation of first amended Administrative Complaint.

C. RN-03 Moshe Reznitzky, R.M.H.C.I., (AAC), Case No. 2019-34416

Mr. Den Beste presented the case to the panel. The department previously filed an Administrative Complaint against Mr. Reznitzky for failing to meet the minimum standards of performance for an R.M.H.C.I. or R.M.F.T.I.. Mr. Reznitzky was represented by Manuel Centurion.
