Alleged Violation: Section 491.009(1)(k), Florida Statutes (2018-2019), by committing any act upon a patient or client which would constitute sexual battery, or which would constitute sexual misconduct as defined pursuant to section 491.0111. The Department asked that the case be dismissed because the alleged client no longer wants to testify.
